### ***Class VI to VIII***

- Write a journal of your day to day activities and what value you inculcated, what lesson you had learnt from your elders.
- Challenge yourself by practicing mathematics in day to day activities which you are doing. Know the market value of different items which you purchase in grocery store and try to analyze the price difference.
- Make reading a habit. Write a review of one book that your read during the holidays.( 200-250 words)
- Observe and tabulate the number of members in a family and number of litres of water being used on each day in your neighbourhood.

*Class IX & XI*

- Read the newspaper and cut out the headline that catches your attention.
- During the holidays take one Headline that captured your imagination/ empathy and write an article in 150-200 words about the same.
- Make reading a habit. Write a review of one book that you read during the holidays.( 200-250 words)
- Observe and tabulate the number of members in a family and number of litres of water being used on each day in your neighbourhood.
